<b>Arsenic</b>	Every well	Test once and retest based upon level detected	<b>\$35.00</b>
<b>Coliform Bacteria (Includes E.coli)</b>	Every well	Test once every year, or when there is a change in taste, color or odor	<b>\$35.00</b>
<b>Fluoride</b>	Wells used by infants and preschool-aged children	Test when infant is born	<b>\$35.00</b>
<b>Hardness</b>	Homes with scum or scale deposits on sinks, toilets. White flakes in water.	Once to detect Hardness level and determine if softener is needed	<b>\$35.00</b>
<b>Iron</b>	Homes with yellow or brownish staining on fixtures or clothing.	Once to detect Iron concentration and determine if treatment is needed	<b>\$35.00</b>
<b>Lead</b>	Homes with plumbing installed before 1985	Consider a one time test	<b>\$35.00</b> +Copper=\$50
<b>Nitrate</b>	Every well	Test annually. If EPA drinking water standard is exceeded it is recommended pesticide/herbicide scans are performed.	<b>\$35.00</b>
